### Your HOA in Action – Dead Tree Removal

The Coventry HOA board engages actively with "Columbus 311 Customer Service Center" to resolve problems and city code violations. For example, residents of Adidas Court had noticed unsightly dying/dead evergreen trees in the adjacent apartment complex for at least a year.

Residents' complaints to the apartment management office went ignored for months. That's when the HOA board trustees worked with Columbus 311 staff to address the problem. Through contact with the city and this free service, action was taken.

The trees were recently removed by the city, and the bill was sent to the apartment complex!

This is just one example of how the Board of Trustees for the HOA work with the city to keep our neighborhood looking good.

Together, we can all do great things to make our community one of an example of a self-run homeowner's association.
